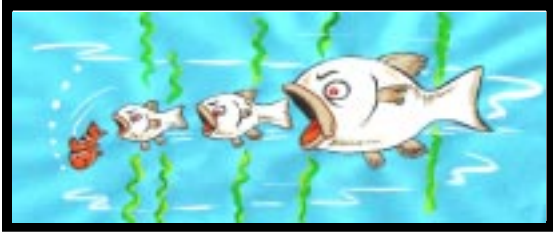

Year-End Leaderboard — Rules of Eligibility

The cost of entry is \$5.00 per **SPECIES**. An angler may enter a larger fish of same **SPECIES** without paying an additional entry fee for that fish. The angler does not have to pay another entry fee until he/she catches a fish that will be entered for a different **SPECIES**. No advance entry fee is required.

Fish must be caught on rod and reel by the angler submitting the entry. A net or gaff may be used to assist with landing the fish. Gigging or spearfishing of any kind is not eligible. Only Legal Fish, example: fish within the Slot Size.

Fish must be caught between Lockwoods Folly in N. Carolina and 14th Ave Pier in Myrtle Beach, SC coastal waters or adjacent federal waters.. In the event a fish is caught from a boat, it must have left from a location between the above named locations.

Fish may be weighed on certified scales. These scales are located in several locations in the fishing area. The angler's portion of the scale weight tag should be submitted to the Leaderboard Committee along with the fee, and signed by the weighmaster. The only exception to this rule concerns Blacktip Sharks and Spinner Sharks. These two species must be measured nose to tail in a way to be most accurate and may be measured in the same way as in official shark tournaments. These are the only species allowed to be catch & release.

Fish weighed on any calibrated tournament scales are also eligible. Examples are, but not limited to, Governor's Cup, SKA, Voyagers View, Huntington Beach State Park and Heiden Tournaments. Fish weight and species must be on that tournaments' entry card and witnessed by the tournament weigh master.

Only members in good standing of the Seacoast Anglers Association are eligible to enter this leader board. A SAA Angler of the Year will be awarded to the angler with the most leader board entries. Awards for each species entered will be presented in December at an announced date.

All entries are subject to the approval of the Leader board Committee. All tied entrants will remain on the board to be tallied for the SAA Angler of the Year Award.

The leader board will take its' last entry for the year at the Annual November Meeting. The new leader board will start the day **AFTER** our Annual November Meeting.

No entries will be accepted for fish caught during a commercial fishing trip. This includes any trip where fish caught by the angler are to be sold or the angler is being paid to work on the vessel on which fish are landed.

Members wishing to enter a fish on the Leader Board must enter the fish and pay the fee at the next regular membership meeting.

These Rules of Eligibility will be absolute and final.
